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LAS Breaks Another Record with 58.4M Passengers in 2024

Air travel to Las Vegas soared to new heights in 2024 as Harry Reid International Airport (LAS) achieved a record-breaking milestone, serving 58.4 million passengers. This marks the third consecutive year of record-setting growth, surpassing the previous benchmark of 57.6 million travelers in 2023.

The annual record was not the only notable achievement in 2024:

- 8 of the 12 months in 2024 set new monthly records.
- October 2024 set the record for the second busiest month ever at LAS, with 5.4 million passengers.
- International travel saw a huge surge with a 13.6 percent increase, compared to 2023.

LAS made significant strides for international air service in 2024:

- Aer Lingus introduced nonstop flights between Las Vegas and Dublin, Ireland.
- Volaris launched nonstop routes to Tijuana, Mexico, creating access to nearly 40 Mexican cities.
- Virgin Atlantic resumed nonstop service to Manchester, England.
- Norse Atlantic Airways began direct flights to London's Gatwick International Airport.
- Porter Airlines brought back seasonal service to Ottawa and Montreal, Canada.
- Korean Air expanded schedules, offering daily flights to and from Seoul, South Korea.

Las Vegas shined bright on the global stage last year. The city hosted its first-ever Super Bowl, raced into its second annual Formula 1 Grand Prix, and served as a key destination for over 25 visits from presidential and vice-presidential candidates during a pivotal election year. In addition, legacy conventions, world-class concerts, and professional sporting events continued to draw millions of visitors.

"Our airport is the gateway to all that Southern Nevada has to offer," said Rosemary Vassiliadis, Clark County Director of Aviation. "From serving our local community and our leisure travelers, this record-breaking year is a testament to the critical role our airport system plays on a global scale. We've embraced the continued growth that comes with the expansive options in the sports and entertainment capital of the world; and we're focused on long-term planning for modernizing and maximizing LAS to continue delivering the exceptional service that travelers have come to expect from the destination."

Also, as part of its commitment to excellent service, LAS introduced new amenities in 2024 to elevate the passenger experience including:

- **Curbside concierge service** which allows travelers to skip lines and check in by dropping off luggage at the Rent-A-Car Center or Terminal 3 departures curb before heading directly to security.
- **Online parking reservations** enable travelers to secure prime parking spots at either terminal up to three months in advance, offering peace of mind, especially during busy holiday weekends.

Looking ahead, the next several years will be crucial for evolving LAS to match Southern Nevada's rapid growth. Addressing challenges such as a landlocked campus and constrained airspace is key to ensuring continued expansion. LAS remains committed to being a catalyst for the region's progress by enhancing infrastructure and maintaining its position as a global origin-and-destination airport and the gateway to the Las Vegas region.
